Travel Report and Guidelines



All recipients of Cancer Council Queensland Travel/Study Grants are required to submit a written report of their studies subsequent to their return to Queensland.

The Travel Report should detail the major areas of study and how the visit may contribute to the understanding and/or management of cancer.

If you attended a meeting as part of the visit, please provide an abstract of your presentation.

The report should include acknowledgement of grants from other funding bodies that contributed to your travel, including name of the grant, the funding body, and the amount of funding granted.

Travel Reports should be submitted by email **within 4 weeks** of returning from your travel. Compliance with this requirement will be taken into consideration in judging future Cancer Council Queensland Travel Grant applications by the applicant.
