Guidelines for Referee Reports



Cancer Council Queensland's Research Fellowships are intended to be amongst the most prestigious awards available to those who have already started and wish to continue a career in medical research in Australia.

Referees are invited to submit a report about the applicant and the applicant's research proposal, including comments on the following :-

- Whether the applicant has the knowledge, skills and creativity to pursue the research program that has been proposed.
- How you see the applicant's future in Australian academic medicine or medical research.
- Where you would place the applicant with respect to the relevant peer group.
- Any particular work which has already been done which would make the applicant worthy of this award.
- The quality of the research proposal.

Referees' reports are treated as strictly confidential and will be available only to members of the Senior Research Fellowship Review Support Committee.
